The Council have delivered -;

- Recruitment of an Apprentice Gardener

- Delivered a heavily subsidised 6 week Summer Playscheme at Whittle Hall and Tim Parry Community Centre
- Funded the research for Sankey Heritage Project
- Part funded the new Pump Track at Dakota Park
- Landscaped a new Rose Garden feature at Tim Parry Recreation Ground
- Installation of new flower planters at Hood Lane Community Centre
- Remodelling of Bewsey Barn Community Centre mezanine area to cover the open stair case to save heat
- Installation of new wall panneling to Whittle Hall Community Centre
- Refurbishment of the floors to Whittle Hall and Tim Parry Community Centre
- Financial support towards the delivery of Warrington Armed Forces Day
- New bird and bat boxes in Childs Wood and Bewsey Barn Community Centre
- Supported the Penketh and Sankey Remembrance Parade
- Installation of a new drainage scheme at Tim Parry Recreation Ground to help prevent the car park flooding.
